Rosettes only will be offered for second through fourth in each class, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Female, Best Brace, Best Stud Dog, Best Brood Matron, Parade of Veterans, Parade of Champions/Titleholders, Best Opposite Sex Altered, Winner Male Altered & Winners Female Altered. Suitable trophies & rosettes will be offered for: High in Trial, Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best Puppy in Breed, Winners Male/Female, First in each Class, and Best Altered in Breed.

The Specialty Winners will also be awarded the **“Troll Arabesque/Vintage Year Memorial Trophy** which is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada will retain this trophy.

The High in Trial winner will also be awarded the **DPCC High in Trial Obedience Trophy**. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. The Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada will retain this trophy.

In addition, Award of Merit rosettes will be awarded (one award of merit for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed.)

JUNIOR HANDLING – SATURDAY, JULY 3, 2010

(Following judging of regular classes)

Entry Fee: \$2.00

Judge: Michelle Czebotarenku

Registration: at the Specialty Ring for 60-90 minutes, and closes ONE HOUR prior to the competition.

Open to all Junior 7 years old and up, but not including 18 years of age as at the date of competition. Dog handled must be a Doberman Pinscher entered in the Specialty in an Official Class or in Exhibition Only. Dog need not be owned by Junior Handler or his/her family members.

Classes offered: (NOTE: No Pee Wee class)

Junior Novice: 7 to 10 years; Junior Open: 7 to 10 years,

Intermediate Novice: 11 to 14 years; Intermediate Open: 11 to 14 years

Senior Novice: 15 to under 18 years; Senior Open: 15 to under 18 years

Rosette & prize for 1st to 4th incl. in each class and for Best Overall.

CLASSES OFFERED

CONFORMATION:

The following Regular CKC classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

Junior Puppy: for any dog 6 months to under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy: for any dog 9 months to under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 to 18 months: for any dog 12 months to under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred: for any dog born in Canada (champions of any country excluded)

Bred by Exhibitor: for any dog owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler *must* be the owner/co-owner *AND* the breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle to dog for further awards.

Open: for all dogs (*note: divided by colour*)

Specials Only: for any dog that has a recorded CKC registration or Even Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. NOTE: A listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move the class dog to the Specials Only class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing fees will NOT be refunded.

Veterans: for all dogs 7 years of age and older. Winners of the Veteran male and Veteran Female will not compete for Championship points, but will go directly into the Best of Breed competition.

Exhibition Only: all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may NOT compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY.

**ADDITIONAL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES:
NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:**

(NOTE: Any dog entered in a Non-regular or Unofficial class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Sire & Get: for Sire and three (maximum) of his Get

Brood Matron & Progeny: for Dam and three (maximum) of her progeny

Brace: for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex). Identical ownership is NO LONGER REQUIRED.

Parade of Veterans: for all dogs that are at least 7 years of age on the day of the Specialty. All participants in Parades MUST be entered also in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs are invited to participate BUT MUST BE ENTERED in the official Veterans' class (Conformation) or for Exhibition Only. (Please provide a written resume of your dog (75 words) with your entry)

Parade of Titleholders: for dogs that hold either a championship or obedience title in Canada. . All participants in Parades MUST be entered also in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only. . (Please provide a written resume of your dog (75 words) with your entry).

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES: (At Specialties only)

Eligibility for Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age that have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points may NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This competition will be judged **AFTER** the completion of Best of Breed judging.

Classes offered: Two only – Altered Male and Altered Female.

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be declared Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed and Best Opposite in Breed..

OBEDIENCE:

NOTE: No dog may be entered in both Novice A & Novice B, or in both Open A & Open B, at the same trial.

REGULAR CLASSES:

Novice A: Open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of CD in any

country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor must be the owner or a member of the owner's immediate family and must show the dog in ALL exercises. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere may compete in this class, but MUST compete in the Novice B class.

Novice B: open to all dogs which have not earned the title of CD. Dog may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN registered to compete in this class.

Open A: Open to all dogs which have earned the title of CD in CANADA, but have not earned the title of CDX in any country. One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor must be the owner or a member of the owner's immediate family and must show the dog in ALL exercises. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere may compete in this class, but MUST compete in the Open B class. A CKC or ERN registration number must be provided on the entry form at the time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.

Open B: open to all dogs which have earned the title of CD in CANADA. Dog may be shown by the owner or any other person. **This dog may also compete in the Utility Class.** A CKC or ERN registration number must be provided on the entry form at the time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.

Utility: Open to all dogs which have earned the title CDX in CANADA.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES:

Brace Class: Open to any two dogs of either sex which have attained not less than a CD title in Canada. Ownership of the dogs need NOT be the same.

Veterans Class: Open to all dogs that have an obedience title and are seven (7) years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. **Dogs entered in the Veterans Class may not be entered in any regular class, but MUST be entered for Exhibition Only.**

NOTE: Dogs entered in the Veterans Class will receive a rosette with their Call Name embossed on it. Please write your dog's CALL NAME on the Obedience entry form.

RALLY OBEDIENCE:

NOTE: No dog may be entered in both Novice A & Novice B, or in both Advanced A & Advanced B, at the same trial.

Rally Novice A: Dogs in this class may not have won a CKC Rally or Obedience Novice title. The handler must be the owner, co-owner, or member of the owner's immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dog may continue to compete in this class until the owner has received official CKC notification that the dog has won the Rally Novice A title

Rally Novice B: Dogs may compete in this class until a qualifying score in Rally Advanced is earned. Any person may handle a dog and may enter more than one dog

in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Rally Advanced A: for dogs that have won the Rally Novice title. The handler must be the owner, co-owner, or member of the owner's immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dog may continue to compete in this class until the owner has received official CKC notification that the dog has won the Rally Advanced A title.

Rally Advanced B: For dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced A (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. Any person may handle a dog and may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring ON leash.

Rally Excellent A: For dogs that have won the Rally Advanced A (R.A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title **or any CKC Novice Obedience title.** The handler must be the owner, co-owner, or member of the owner's immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dog may continue to compete in this class until the owner has received official CKC notification that the dog has won the Rally Excellent A title

Rally Excellent B: For dogs that have won the Rally Advanced A (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced A (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. Any person may handle a dog and may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash except the Honour exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring ON leash.

EXCERPTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES

Ch. 4.1.3. Judges: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subject to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively enforced.

Section 3.1 Entries and Entry Fees: Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, be eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification Number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually with the CKC it may be entered at a show held under these rules as a "listed" dog, provided:

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC Registration Number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A Listing Fee of \$8.50 per show entered must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3: Incomplete Entries: Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the win being cancelled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2: Dishonoured Cheques: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonoured cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

Chapter 14.1.4 Disqualification: A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by such a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules.

Chapter 9: Exhibitors and their Dogs: A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 - The schedule to be employed in the determining of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows

Dogs Competing Includes the dog awarded Winners.	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL be included in the calculation for championship points (absentees are not included).

NOTE: In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion, and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must:

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges
- be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number
- have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level

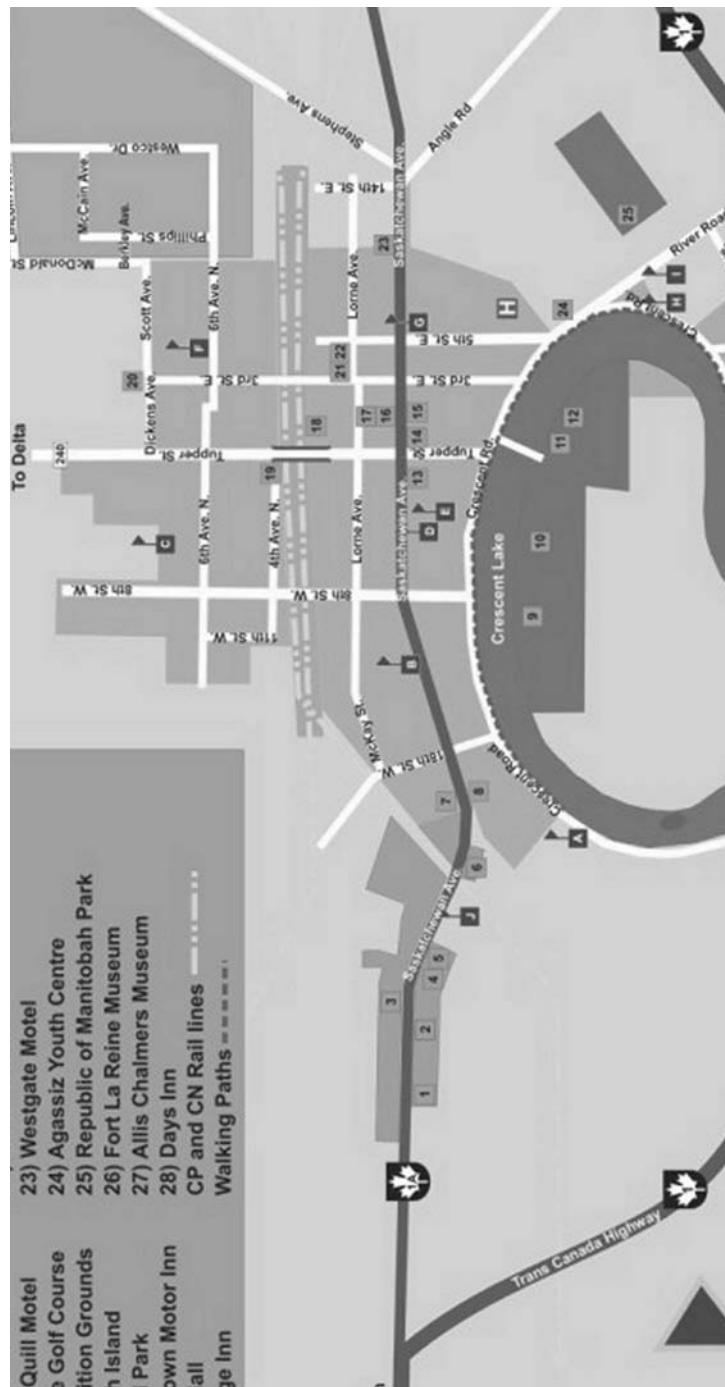
